

### A Word of Encouragement for the New Year...

Scripture Reading— Joshua 1:1-9 "Do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go" (1:9)

On the first day of a new year many of us wish each other a "Happy New Year." But as we begin a new year we need more than a hopeful greeting from the people around us. We need to listen to what God told Joshua about 3,400 years ago. As Joshua was about to lead God's people into the promised land, he had reason to be afraid. He had an enormous task ahead of him, and he was aware of the dangers his people would face. He needed God's encouragement. A new year brings lots of



questions. Will our health hold? Will I get into the right school? Will the fires ever go out? Will I have enough money to retire? The Creator of the universe comes to us and says, "Don't be afraid, don't be discouraged." What happens in this coming year is not left to chance. God is in charge, and He promises to stay close. "The LORD your GOD will be with you wherever you go." Many years later, the Lord Jesus Made the same promise when He said, "I am with you always" (Matthew 28:20). It's because of God and His promises that we can truly wish each other a "Happy New Year!"



#### Figures from The Mustard Tree - 2019

Total Income for Shop and Café for 2019 - \$441,038 \$75,287 more than 2018

The number of clients seen in Foodbank and Pharmacy Assistance in 2019 was 1,478.

This was 165 more than 2018.

Over 300 emergency packs have been given out in the shop and 250 packs for Corrections Services. This works out to enough food for around 42,000 meals compared to 35,451 in 2018.

The Mustard Tree was able to pay for 127 prescriptions for clients throughout the year. We have a hairdresser who comes in for one afternoon each month. During the year she was able to do over 100 free haircuts for clients, customers and volunteers.

Throughout the year we fed more than 1600 people from our community through Community Table, the free meal held each Tuesday during school term. The highest number of people attending Community Table was at our last meal for the year when over 100 people came to enjoy a festive Christmas lunch.

We sent off 24,263kg of clothing, shoes and bags that had been donated but we were unable to sell due to our strict quality controls. That's over 24 ton.

The oldest volunteer working in the shop is 87 and the youngest is 15.



The Mustard tree is an image used in the Bible by Jesus to illustrate the Kingdom of God. In the story Jesus told, the mustard seed is the word of God proclaimed by Jesus. As it grows in the hearts and minds of men and women it brings hope and life eternal. "How can I describe the Kingdom of Heaven? What story should I use to illustrate it? It is like a mustard seed planted in the ground. It is the smallest of all seeds, but it becomes the largest of all the garden plants; it grows long branches and birds can make a nest in its shade."

#### Gospel of Mark 4:30-32.

The Mustard Tree op shop in a similar fashion offers comfort, care and community to all. It is an expression of God's love through God's people as we care and provide for physical, emotional and spiritual needs of those we meet.




